A training programme to empower members of your faith community to engage with and support families who have young children.



If you are a part of a Christian community and are passionate about enhancing parish life and the experience of our young families, ask your local parish about becoming a Side by Side Mentor.

Mentors are asked to:

- attend the three training sessions
- participate in mentoring
- engage in ongoing reflection and networking

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When young families become a rare sight at Church, what can we do about it? How do we engage them? How do we make them feel welcome?

Side by Side Mentoring equips everyday people to:

- actively engage and relate to young families
- encourage and motivate them in their parenting role
- offer parents the experience of a supportive faith community
- assure parents they are valued and not alone in their parenting journey.

Mentors are recruited from their own church communities. They will need the approval of their priest or pastor and will complete an application form, giving permission for a police check.
