Chunga Mwema Secondary School (MMSS), Kagera, Tanzania is in the process of building a new School Hall at a cost of approximately NZ\$100,000. This will enable the students to gather out of the sun in the hot weather and to keep dry to have their meals in the rainy seasons. The Hall will also serve as a venue for state exams. A recent government inspection of the school ordered that this be built in order for the school to stay open. Please donate today to help us build this new hall!

The rural Kunri Christian School Tuition Centre in Pakistan has reached its 2018 funding target. This is just awesome! With the donations received all the buildings for the new centre can be

completed. In October classes started with 20 students in the existing 3 rooms. Once the additional 9 rooms have been built so many more children will be supported with their studies. The new centre is working well and the kids love coming. When asked which is the best part of their school day the kids say "the bible class!".

St John's University Fence project in Tanzania has been completed with a new inner pathway around the fence perimeter for guard patrols, and the fence has received additional strengthening. Thank you to everyone who donated to this project to make the University safer for students and staff.

Edaid has partnered with the **The East West Educational Foundation (EWEF) in New Delhi, India** to build a Christian International School teaching international fee-paying students as well as local children attending on scholarships.
